## <u>Applicant Requirements</u>

- Must be Naperville residents or attend a high school in District 203 or 204.
- Must submit an application, resume and letter of recommendation from an adult (other than a parent or relative) who knows the applicant well.
- Must serve a one-year term, beginning in April.
- Will adhere to a zero tolerance policy regarding drugs, alcohol, weapons, and other illegal substances.
- Willing and able to commit time and efforts to us (could be from 2-10 hours a week, depending on the applicants role and time of upcoming events/activities)
