- Promote Alive and the NaperBridge Teen Program to your school and friends
- Create and run the NaperBridge events and initiatives
- Plan, promote and run NaperBridge programs, events and special initiatives
- Be active on our NaperBridge Student Board Facebook group

Applicant Requirements

- Applicants must be Naperville residents or attend a high school in District 203 or 204.
- Applicants must submit an application, resume and letter of recommendation from an adult (other than a parent or relative) who knows the applicant well.
- Applicants must serve a one-year term, beginning in April.
- Applicants will adhere to a zero tolerance policy regarding drugs, alcohol, weapons, and other illegal substances.
- Applicants are willing and able to commit time and efforts to us (Could be anywhere from 2-10 hours in a given week, depending on the applicants role and time of upcoming events/activities)

- NaperBridge Alive will contact chosen applicants for interviews to be scheduled in late March or April.
